- The Marcellus Shale is the second largest known shale deposit in the world.
- Experts currently estimate that up to 2,445 trillion cubic feet (Tcf) of reserves are in place with recoverable reserves estimated at 489 Tcf.
- Annual natural gas usage in the US is currently 20 Tcf.
