MUNICIPAL STATISTICS E-FILING WEBINAR THINGS YOU MUST KNOW ABOUT THE PROCESS

The four dates originally scheduled for this topic have filled quickly! In order to meet the demand for this information, the Governor's Center has added a fifth session, scheduled for January 12, 2012, from noon-1:30PM. Space is limited, so register today!

In fiscal year 2009-2010, the Governor's Center for Local Government Services began a proactive approach to the e-filing of all required forms – the Tax Information Form, Elected and Appointed Officials Form, the Survey of Financial Condition and the Municipal Annual Audit and Financial Report. School districts were the first to comply with this requirement, and were followed by county government in 2010. DCED has now prepared a plan for the e-filing of the four DCED forms within all 2,562 municipalities in PA. This plan, which will begin immediately, will continue over the next four years.

To aid municipalities with this new e-filing requirement, a Webinar Training Series sponsored by the PA Local Government Training Partnership will be held from noon to 1:30 PM on January 12, 2012 –The session will inform participants of the registration process and give step-by-step instructions on how to e-file the Tax Information Form, Elected and Appointed Officials Form, the Survey of Financial Condition and the Municipal Annual Audit and Financial Report.

- Instantly and accurately transmit your DCED forms and reduce filing time
- Easily access your current and previously e-filed forms
- Save your time and eliminate postage costs associated with forms filing

The DCED Municipal Statistics system requires Microsoft Internet Explorer 6.0 or later.
